Many of you were familiar with the CARES funding, and now, we are in receipt of funds under the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act or the HEERF 2 CRRSAA program and, also, funds are available under the American Relief Plan or the HEERF 3 ARP. Simply stated, we can now assist students enrolled online and even international students. To help us help you, if you were enrolled at the College on March 1, 2020 (the month the national health emergency was declared), we are asking you to complete the simplified [application](#).

We can expedite completion of your course schedule for Fall 2021 including allocating student aid to pay off some, or all of your, balances from Spring 2020, Summer 2020, Fall 2020, Spring, 2021, Summer 2021. If you qualify and with your consent, the College can apply some or all of a student aid grant to your account for the Fall 2021 semester. These funds, however, cannot be used to pay off any other loans. Students interested in applying for these funds must complete and submit the on fine application. Please ensure that your contact information is current. Your application will be reviewed and administered through the Office of Financial Aid As we begin the 2021-2022 academic year, I just want to assure you that you will have the necessary resources to support your continued enrollment.
