

CONSTITUTION OF MILES COLLEGE

(REVISED BY BOARD OF TRUSTEES OCTOBER, 1967)

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of this institution shall be Miles College.

ARTICLE II. OBJECTIVES AND PURPOSES

The objectives and purpose of this institution are: to foster and support a liberal arts college or institution of higher education which has as its objectives, the usual and various kinds of literary, professional, industrial, commercial and religious courses and services ordinarily and usually undertaken and conducted by such an educational institution, and to do such other work as is permitted under the Charter of the College granted by the State of Alabama to educational institutions.

ARTICLE III. NON-PROFIT

The work of this institution shall be benevolent and non-profit. No dividends shall be declared nor shall any profit accrue to individuals except as shall be legitimate payment of salaries to employees engaged in conducting the work.

ARTICLE IV. CONTROL AND COMPOSITION

Section 1. Control

The control of the College shall be vested in a Board of Trustees.

Section 2. Composition of the Board

The Board of Trustees shall be composed or constituted by representatives from the Fifth Episcopal District of the Christian Methodist Episcopal Church, the Board of Christian
