Declaration of Incorporation Of MILES MEMORIAL COLLEGE

S. Williams, R. L. Langford and S. J. Elliott, were duly elected as trustees of the hereinafter name organization or institution; that the first three trustees herein name were elected for years; the second three for two years; and the last three for one year; that the corporate name selected for said organization is, "MILES MEMORIAL COLLEGE"; that the corporation is to exercise its functions and carry on its work in Jefferson County, Alabama, and that its general objective and purposes are as follows: To establish, conduct and maintain an educational institution of collegiate rank; to receive students upon such terms and conditions as it may impose; to adopt, establish and maintain such courses of study as it may deem proper, or as are usual with educational institutions of like rank; to provide, grant, and issue diplomas, confer degrees, meritorious and honorary, in accordance with its own rules, or as may be customary with like institutions; to purchase, lease, sell, mortgage, and hold real and personal property for its own use, as provided by law; to receive property by gift, will or devise, holding the same in conformity with all lawful conditions imposed by the donor; and to exercise such other powers as are incident to private corporations.
