Fire Evacuation Plan and Procedure

Step 1: In the event of a fire and/or smoke, the Dorm Director is to call **911**.

Step 2: Dorm Director will contact Campus Security. (205-929-1722)

Step 3: Dorm Director will then alert the Director of Housing and the Vice President/Dean of Students. (Call the Mobile Numbers of both parties.)

Step 4: The Dorm Director, Resident Assistants (RAs), and Fire Captains begin the evacuation process of evacuating all occupants of the Residence Hall through the designated exits.

- Each Dorm Director, RA, and Fire Captain is aware of every Exit from the hall.
- (Fire Captains are additional designated students that aid with Fire Drills and actual Fire Evacuations.)

Step 5: The Dorm Director, RAs, and Fire Captains assist Campus Security in getting everyone at least 100 feet away from the building.

- They are also responsible for insuring that students/occupants are not blocking areas that will be vital for the Fire Department and Fire Trucks to navigate to the closest water source.

Step 6: Once completely clear of the building, the Dorm Director, RAs, and Fire Captains will start to take a tally/role in order to deduce who is accounted for and check for injuries. (**Medical Attention will also be sought for those that need it.**) (Reconciliation will be aided by official roles that can be retrieved from another facility/building.)

Step 7: All occupants, Directors, RAs, Fire Captains, etc. will then wait for clearance and next instructions from the Fire Department.
