1.0 FILING INSTRUCTIONS

1.1 Only a student who received federal student aid at Miles College during the 2015-2016 school year should use this application to apply for summer school aid. All other students must file the Free Application for Federal Student Aid 2015-16

(See 1.2). (The purpose of filing this separate application for summer school is to inform the Financial Aid office (currently enrolled students) as early as possible that you plan to attend summer school.

1.2 If you are applying for Federal Student Aid at Miles College for the first time (2015 -2016 academic year), you must file the Free Application for Federal Student Aid. For the 2015-2016 summer session only the 2015-2016 Free Application for Federal Student aid can be used to secure aid for the 2015-2016 Summer Session.

1.3 If you did not receive federal aid at Miles College but you did receive federal aid at another college, please contact the Federal Student Aid Processing Center and add the Miles College school code to your Free Application for Federal Student Aid for the 2015-2016 school year, so that the College can receive your record. If you have received the full amount of your Federal Student Aid (Federal Pell Grant and/or Subsidized/Unsubsidized loans) at another school, you may not be eligible for additional aid for the 2015-16 School year. Ask the Financial Aid Staff to assist you in determining if you have received the maximum aid for the 2015-16 school year. the College, as well as you (the student), have access to their data via the Federal Student Aid System (www.NSLDS.ed.gov). The Federal Code for Miles College is 001028. The telephone number for the Federal Student Aid Processing Center is 1- 800-433-3243. Also, you will use the Federal Student aid number (assigned to you by the Federal Processing Center) to return to your file at the website www.fafsa.ed.gov; and, add Miles College code 001028 as the school you want to receive your Free Application for Federal Student Aid record.

1.5 All aid for the Summer Session must be processed and applied to your Business Office Account no later than June 15, 2016. Federal Student Aid is time period specific, and must be processed before the time period expires.

1.6 Funds are limited, **do not leave any section of your application incomplete!**
